#### TO OUR AUDIENCE

THE STORY is set in 15th century France, ruled over by a weak, incompetent Louis XI, at a time when the country is threatened by the ambitious Duke of Burgundy, whose army is at the gates of Paris.

Louis, more concerned with the ladies of his court than his duties of statesmanship, visits, in disguise, a tavern in one of the more disreputable parts of the city, hoping to discover the identity of a man known to be competing with him for the affections of a lady of court, Katherine de Vaucelles. In the tavern he finds some of the lowest desperadoes of Paris, led by one Francois Villon, dare-devil and thief, but also poet and scholar, and acknowledged leader of the Paris underworld. Unaware of the King's identity, Villon derides Louis' weak efforts to protect his country, and boasts of what he would do if he were king. Katherine too, appears at the tavern to enlist Villon's help, asking him to kill Thibaut d'Aussigny, the Grand Marshal of France, who has turned traitor and is plotting to deliver Paris to the Burgundians. Villon picks a quarrel with Thibaut, and in the ensuing duel Thibaut is wounded and Villon, with his companions, is arrested by the Royal Guard.

Remembering Villon's boasts, Louis plans revenge. He offers Villon the rank of Grand Marshal, and with it the authority of king for one day, at the end of which time he will be hanged unless he can win for himself Katherine's love. Villon accepts the challenge and plans to rout the Burgundians and win the hand of Katherine.

Thibaut again fights a duel with Villon, and this time is killed. Katherine, as a reward, gives her hand to the new Grand Marshal, but Villon scorns deception and reveals his true identity. Katherine, shocked and disgusted, recoils from him and rejects his love.

So Villon continues his reign for a day. The Burgundian ultimatum is rejected and he, and his rabble, inflict a complete rout upon the invaders. Paris is saved, and all that remains for the Grand Marshal is to order his own execution under the terms of his agreement with Louis. But as the end draws near, Katherine, realising her true love for Villon, gives her heart and hand, not to a Grand Marshal, but to a Vagabond King.
