Welcome to Burton Musical Theatre Company's 70th Anniversary Show. In 1952 Burton Operatic Society, as we were originally known, performed 'The Gondoliers' by Gilbert and Sullivan. Since then we have performed a diverse range of shows and are very pleased to celebrate this anniversary with our production of 'Evita'.

The music was first written by the song writing team of Andrew Lloyd Webber and Tim Rice as an album musical in 1976. It was then transformed into a stage musical and the original West End production opened at The Prince Edward Theatre on 21st June 1978 and closed on 18th February 1986 after 3176 performances. Elaine Page as 'Eva', David Essex as 'Che' and Joss Ackland as 'Peron' are names that many will remember.

In our production the talented Ed Moore as 'Che' and Andy Last as 'Peron' return to the stage alongside Eleanor Cawser as a stunning 'Eva' in her first principal lead with BMTC.

Director, Steven Foster, Musical Director, David Blackwell and Choreographers, Dannie Berriman and Helena Stone, have once again succeeded in bringing to stage a difficult show, both musically and dramatically. Our Lighting, Sound, Stage Building and Props Teams have, as usual, responded to the challenges of the show by enhancing the onstage performers.

Looking forwards we have two exciting shows planned for 2023 - 'Footloose' in February and 'Kinky Boots' in October so we look forward to seeing you all in the audience.

SYNOPSIS

Evita is the story of Argentina's most controversial First Lady Eva Peron (1919 – 1952). Her awe-inspiring funeral, attended by seven million devoted followers, is the opening to the musical, with the embittered and cynical narrator 'Che' then bringing the story back over a decade, explaining how a B-movie actress became the object of such controversial devotion.

It is clear that Eva quickly learns that her feminine wiles hold power among a culture, and a political system, run by men. Once she makes it to Buenos Aires she is determined to become a star and uses her feminine wiles to climb the ladder of the city's entertainment scene, eventually becoming a well-paid radio and film actress.

At a benefit to aid victims of an earthquake, she meets Colonel Juan Peron, an ambitious politician with designs on the Presidency. They fall in love and Eva encourages his plans to become dictator of the country, even using her star power to get him released from prison when his enemies order his arrest. On February 24th 1946, Peron is elected President with a huge majority, but it quickly becomes apparent that it is his glamorous wife who is the focus of people's love.

Affectionately nicknamed 'Evita' by her millions of devoted followers, Eva founds a huge charity to alleviate the suffering of the nation's poor. Throughout it all, the beautiful first lady is dressed in the latest high fashion and she is accused of being a distraction for the people, rather than an aid. With millions of people still utterly devoted to her, Eva continues to appear in public dazzling her supporters and enfuriating her enemies, despite being secretly consumed with terminal cancer.

Her huge political influence and constant charity works earned her scorn and fear from the military and upper classes. Her legendary life is displayed before your eyes as the most hated and most beloved woman in Argentina.
